- Members must be participating directly in the developing world project for which they are seeking funding.
- In general, in order to be considered for funding, projects must fall into the areas of financial and general education or cultural and community social programs.
- The criteria underlying the current list of developing countries are:
  - **low income** – based on a three-year average estimate of the gross national income per capita;
  - **weak human assets** – based on skill sets/available education as measured through a composite Human Assets Index; and
  - **economic vulnerability** - as measured through a composite Economic Vulnerability Index.
